## Citizenship Papers Required by Law

The following is a proclamation from the Shadow Fey Lords:

Let it be known that all residents of Valdarin's Gate must register with the Court of Shadow within one moon. Once registered, you will be an official citizen recognized by the new government of Valdarin's Gate. Those who fail to register will be severely fined and punished accordingly.

Those who register will receive citizenship papers that must be carried on your person at all times. If you lose your citizenship papers you must pay to receive new ones. Those who fail to produce these documents when asked for will be severely fined and punished accordingly.

Registered citizens will be under the protection of the Shadow Court and will enjoy all privileges granted to citizens, including, but not limited to: the right to hold office, the right to vote in elections, the right to fair trial, and the right to utilize official buildings such as the Library, Temple, Permanent Circles, and the Tavern. Unregistered citizens receive no rights.

## New Library for Citizens

I have been "politely" ordered to announce that a new library is being prepared for the town's use. The library will be placed in one of the buildings in Lowtown, and is a generous gift from our new Lords, the Fey of the Court of Shadow.

The Marquis Nightwatch has declared that the library will be free for all officially-recognized citizens to use. Citizens in good standing will reap the benefits of the invaluable knowledge contained within, and the Marquis has assured me that many of his own personal tomes and scrolls of knowledge will be invested into the library.

All citizens are encouraged to donate any valuable information to the library, a voluntary action which will be enforced by the Shadow Guard. Citizens found withholding such information, whether in the form of books, scrolls, or any other such written words, will be fined and punished accordingly. Citizens have until the library has opened to donate willingly - after that the Shadow Guard will collect all such information by searching every building and person.

A Ward of Protection will be cast on the library to keep anyone from stealing or destroying any of the items and knowledge in the building. The Warlock Grimheed will cast this ritual when the time is right, and any citizens who wish to aid in the casting will be rewarded.

## Temple of Light to be Restored

As we all know, the Temple of Light was closed by the King's men due to various circumstances - I hear that one reason is that the town failed to pay its taxes. Since the Good King and his nobles are not be found anywhere near this area these days, I suppose his ruling is a moot point.

So without further ado, the following is yet another proclamation from the Shadow Fey Lords:

Let it be known that the Temple of Light that was closed will be open again once more for all Loyal

Citizens to benefit from. All registered Citizens will be allowed entry, regardless of affiliation.

The Noble Fey Lords shall cast a Ward Ritual to protect the Temple and grant beneficial and restorative effects to those who pay respect to it.

This is a Glorious Gift from the Most Noble Court of Shadow to the Loyal Citizens of Valdarin's Gate.

Those who disrespect, vandalize, or disrupt other Citizens within the temple will be severely fined and punished accordingly.

## Citizen Elections to be Held

The Viscount Devos has announced that he will be overseeing the elections of citizens to several positions he named. I'm not sure how much sway and authority these positions will actually hold, but it's a start.
