Potatoes in a blanket.

1 lb of baby potatoes

1lb favorite bacon cut in half

2 TBS olive oil

1 tsp adobo

1 tsp freshly cracked black pepper

1 tsp granulated garlic

1 tsp salt

2 tsp smoked paprika

3 tsp maple syrup (or BBQ sauce)

Preheat oven to 350 degrees

Place foil over baking sheet and spray with cooking spray

Combine spices and olive oil into a large bowl and mix well.

Add potatoes to spice and oil mixture and stir well to coat.

Cut bacon in half

Wrap potatoes with bacon placing the "seam" side of the bacon on the cooking sheet.

Bake for 35 min

Remove from oven and brush with maple syrup or BBQ sauce

Bake again for 10 min.
